Route, North on US 395 at Mt. Vernon (limited gas). Through Long Creek, Dale, turn right at Ukiah on Rt. 244 to I84 at Hilgard. Turn North at La Grande on OR 82 through La Grande (gas, supplies) to Elgin on to Enterprize. There is roadside rest on Rt. 82 near Minam (Lunch). From Enterprize on to Joseph and along lake to Oregon State Park. Left turn into park. Reservations made for 12 rigs, 7 nights, first night paid \$20 plus \$6 reservation fee. Check accepted at entrance for \$120 last time.

Route to Baker City is back to La Grande, 184 to Baker City, Exit 302 to Hughes Rd. north. Mt. View Best Holiday Trailer Park on left. Reservations made for first night. Pay 2nd night.
