

DIRECTIONS TO THE AUGUST SNU TWIN LAKES RALLY

Take Rt 395 south to Bridgeport, CA, about 110 miles south of Reno. Turn right on the Twin Lakes road next to the gas station just as you enter town. Take the Twin Lakes road about 15 to 20 miles, turn left on the road to the Twin Lakes campground. Cross the bridge and turn left to the Crags Campground. The group campground is on the right after you enter the campground.
