SNU announcement list

If you haven't already subscribed to the SNU email announcement list, now is a great time to do that. Subscribing is simple, just check the link listed in this newsletter. Anyone, SNU member or not can subscribe. As a subscriber on the list you will receive announcements that the current SNU newsletter has been posted on the website. You will also get occasional notices regarding any changes in rally or lunch information and other items of importance to SNU members. The SNU uses a subscription system rather than just emailing everyone who has an email address out of respect for individual personal preferences and in recognition of current spam laws. By subscribing, the individual is telling the SNU, yes I want to receive notice about the newsletter. It isn't the SNU assuming this is so. This also means that if your email address changes, you need to re-subscribe and re-confirm your subscription with your new email address. This ensures the SNU that again, you do want to continue receiving announcements about the newsletter and other information. Even though you can go directly to the website to see the newsletters, it is important to subscribe to the announcement list, especially if your are an SNU member. Unless the SNU receives your subscription, we will continue to send you the newsletter via snail mail to ensure that, as a member, you will not miss out on current info about the SNU. SNU 2009 Highlights

The SNU continued to grow and enjoy new adventures in 2009. Among the highlights of 2009 are:

- ♦ The SNU participated in two community service events, One was a rally at the Silver Springs Air Show where we cooked pancake breakfasts and provided other volunteer services. The other was our rally at Sweetwater Summit where we participated in Amateur Radio Field Day activities.
- ♦ Average attendance at rallies was 7 Airstreams. Three members attended their first rally in 2009. Guests and visitors are always welcome at our rallies and meetings. In 2009 we had five guests at rallies, 2 at Sweetwater, 2 at Obsidian, and 1 at Mason Valley. We also had guests at our February lunch. Visitors included Presidents of two different Californian Units, relatives of SNU members and some Good Sam members who stopped by the Weed Heights rally to check it out before their rally the following weekend. Bill and Jan Heaton also stopped by the Weed Heights rally.
