Prez Meanderings

As the International meeting approaches proposed changes to the WBCCI Constitution become of more interest because they must be addressed at the June international meeting in Huron, North Dakota. The first one that seems to be a no-brainer is a change that will allow members to electronically pay their yearly dues using the WBCCI website. I will assume all members agree with this change. If you do not agree with this change call me at the number below. Otherwise I will instruct our delegate, Don Williams, to cast a vote representing our 31 members in favor of this change.

The second amendment concerns revised qualification for membership. The new wording for membership qualification would read "An adult who owns a hard sided recreational vehicle manufactured by Airstream, Inc., or a class A motor home manufactured by Thor Industries, Inc., beginning with the 2007 model year, shall be eligible for membership. Ownership of a Thor manufactured class A motor home shall be by a LIFE or minimum 10 year membership". The bold face portions are the changes to the constitution article. Personally I do not understand the last boldface sentence. I think it was intended to imply that those that seek membership because they own a Thor Industries, Inc. Class A motor home of model year 2007 or later, must join as a LIFE member or through a 10 year membership. All those attending the rally at Ft Sage were adamant that such an amendment should be defeated. Such attempts to boost membership by allowing non-Airstream logo products have not had that effect. Unless I here otherwise from unit members I will instruct our delegate, Don Williams, to cast a vote representing our 31 members not in favor of this change.

The chairperson of the Region Rally in Lodi in October has asked that each unit prepare and bring a Basket that contains items that represent the unit activities and local attractions of the area the unit represents. I am looking for suggestions. These baskets will be displayed during the Rally and

raffled off at the end of the Rally.

Please call me (775-781-1839) with your objections to the default way I intend to instruct our delegate to vote. Also give me any suggestion for our unit basket.

May Rally at Rocky Point East

Rocky Point East at Eagle Lake is the site of the May Rally. The dates are Thursday May 16 to Sunday 19, 2013. To get to the rally site from Susanville travel north on Highway 139 for 30 miles. Turn west (left) on County Road A-1 and travel approximately 5 miles. Turn south (left) on Lakeside drive in the Bucks Bay subdivision. Drive past some houses. There are various camping and other BLM signs including a BLM sign saying Rocky Point Fishing Access. Follow the road around Bucks Bay to the rally site. Be sure you are heading to Rocky Point East. Rocky

point is a great place for fishing, hiking and just enjoying spectacular scenery. It looks like plans for a special dinner are in the works.
