Subject: Suspension of Sierra Nevada Unit of WBCCI Charter

Dear Mr. Haskett,

Since 2007 the Constitution and Bylaws Committee of WBCCI has been asking your Unit to comply with **Article VI**, **Sec. 2** of the International Bylaws; submission and approval by the Committee of your Units constitution and bylaws. To date an approved copy of those documents has not been provided.

**Article VI Sec. 2** requires all Units, chartered by WBCCi, to have a current an approved copy of their governing documents on file at the central office of WBCCI. Also, that the documents be reviewed and approved by the Unit membership every five years and resubmitted to the central office for approval of any possible changes. The last submitted and approved document of the Sierra Nevada Unit was from 2002.

WBCCI is a 501 (C) 7 organization and your Unit operates under the Internal Revenue authorization of this tax exempt status with a charter issued by WBCCI. Certain conditions of supervision by the chartering organization must be adhered to maintain the status. The submission and approval of the governing documents of the Unit by the Constitution and Bylaws Committee of WBCCI is one of those conditions.

The Sierra Nevada Unit of WBCCI by not providing governing documents approved by the parent organization places the tax status of the organization in possible jeopardy. As your Unit, which has been given many opportunities to provide such documents, has not done so the International Board of Trustees are being asked to suspend the charter of the Sierra Nevada Unit of WBCCI until such time as approved documents are provided. A copy of the motion for suspension is included with this letter.
