The Pioche Million Dollar Court House. Below we look over Pioche to the East toward Echo Lake, bottom, where we will spend several days.

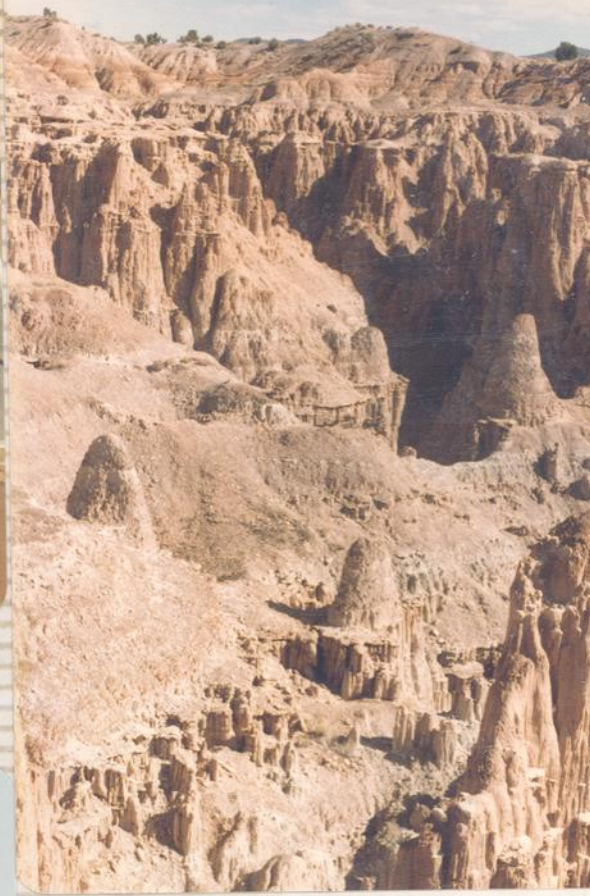
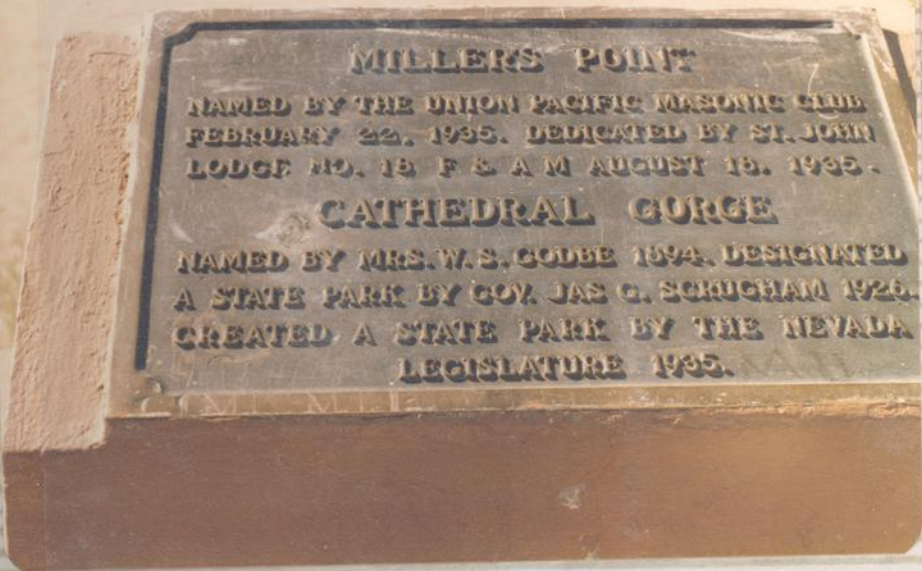


The lake is small and seepage keeps it low. There are trout that didn't bite and many small crappie that would bite anything.

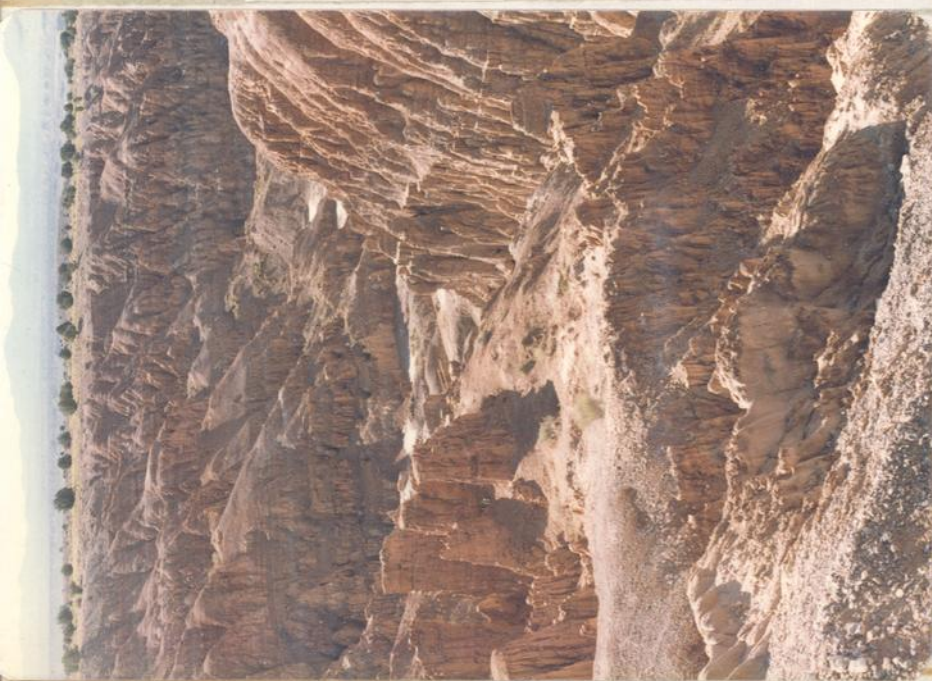




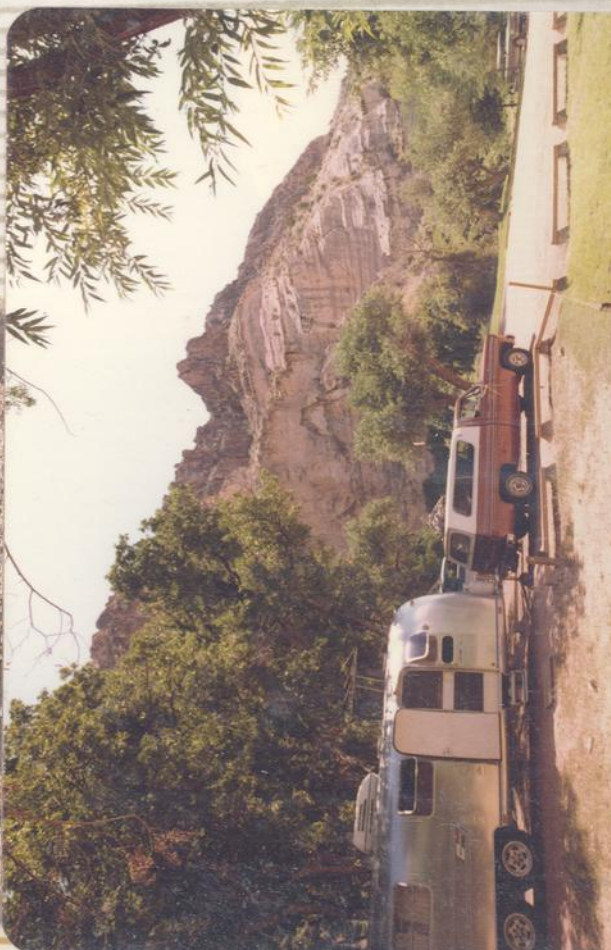
