Dear Fellow WBCCI Member:

All of us are concerned about declining membership. A trend that started in 1979. The WBCCI membership has declined from 25,037 in 1979 to approximately 15,000 currently. A decline of 40% in just eleven years.

No matter what your belief about current membership levels, a 40% decline is not very healthy and acceptable.

Membership retention and possible growth is a challenge to all concerned.

Delegates at this year's International Rally will have an opportunity to vote on critical constitutional amendment(s).

The Airstream Class 190 B-Van is up for vote for acceptance by the membership on June 30, 1990.

There are two pending legislative amendments both addressing the issue.

The "Orange County California Unit Amendment" limits membership to include only the 190 B-Van and exclude all other Airstream products except the Classic.

The IBT Amendment provides an opportunity for all Airstream vehicles a vote on an individual basis as well as the 190 B-Van on June 30, 1990.

Obviously Airstream supports acceptance of all its products by the WBCCI.

Furthermore, it appears to me that passage of the IBT Amendment on June 30, 1990 would allow the Orange County California Unit proposal to be accepted on the floor at the delegates meeting also on June 30, 1990.
