WBCCI'S Big Red Stars

At the Region 12 Rally held in Jackson, California I took a walk in the afternoon and swear I had never seen so many stars under a clear, blue sky. Not bright, twinkling stars in the night sky above, but ten big red stars on an Airstream B Van! I headed over and knocked on the door where I met Dorothy and Ernest Farinha of the Lake Tahoe Airstream Club.

Not familiar with WBCCI's red stars? Each star represents five years of WBCCI (Wally Byam Caravan Club International) membership which means Dorothy and Ernest have the honor of being part of an extraordinary group of only 24 club members celebrating 50+ years of membership!

Dorothy, or Dot, grew up in Auburn, CA while Ernie resided in nearby Lincoln. College sweethearts who met while attending Placer Junior College, they celebrated 63 years of marriage in February.

Always curious to discover *why* a member chooses an Airstream over other brands, Ernie shared that in 1966 it was a friend who convinced them to purchase their first Airstream. For \$4,000, they hitched up a 1966 20' GlobeTrotter and the rest, as they say, is history.

Over the next hour we reminisced about their Airstream experiences enjoyed over the past half-century that have included travel to 49 states and all of Canada's provinces. The Farinha's participated in several caravans including the 1967 caravan to Mexico with 57 Airstreams and 65 children. I was amazed to hear this caravan was accomplished not only in their 20' GlobeTrotter, but also with their four young children between the ages of 2 and 11. It was not surprising to learn their next Airstream purchase gave the family more room to travel together in a 30' Sovereign.



Other caravans included the Eastern Canada adventure in 1968 with 450 Airstreams; the Cajun Caravan, and in 1995 the Newfoundland Experience.

Not only were caravans on their Bucket List, but International Rallies were also. In all they have attended 27 Internationals around the United States and Canada. Two particular Internationals brought back vivid memories. The first was the 1976 Louisville International where it rained nine days straight. When the bullpen, where attendees wait to be parked at the event, turned into a sea of mud, Ernie pitched in to pull many Airstreams out of the bullpen.

The other interesting memory was the 1968 Grand Island, Nebraska International when a tornado warning, in the middle of the night, required attendees to gather under the racetrack's grandstand at 4:00 a.m.

Dot and Ernie, who full-timed for a decade starting in the mid-90s, have held WBCCI membership in four Region 12 clubs beginning with the NorCal Unit in 1966, the Santa Clara Unit in 1969, charter members of the Golden West Unit in 1971 and are currently members of the brand new Lake Tahoe Airstream Club. Now on their 10th Airstream in 50 years, they are looking ahead to the Salem, Oregon International Rally in 2018. When I asked if there was a rocking chair *anywhere* in their future Ernie adamantly replied, "No, no, no!"

Cecelia Stansbury, 1st Vice President

Cecelia and Bob joined the WBCCI in November 2002 after purchasing a 25' Safari. They owned a cabin with friends off Highway 88 since the early 1970s and with their children grown, decided to sell their interest and buy a 'cabin on wheels'. In 2006, they upgraded to a new 28' Classic and love it. The Stansbury's served in leadership roles in the Greater Bay Area Airstream Club (formerly Santa Clara Unit) before helping to create the Lake Tahoe Airstream Club. Cecelia served as Recording Secretary at the International level in 2012-13 while Bob served as Region 12 President in 2013-15. We think they are the first couple to hold both Region and International positions!

Cecelia received a Legal Secretarial Degree from Armstrong University in Berkeley and held numerous other positions, including IT work, when computers were finding their way into the work place. She has also served in varying positions within the Legal Secretaries Association. Both Cecelia and Bob are active in their church where they also hold leadership roles.

During their years in the WBCCI, they have participated in five caravans and various special event rallies along with 12 International Rallies. In April 2018, Cecelia and Bob will celebrate 50 years of marriage while enjoying the Civil War Caravan. They feel the friendships they have formed and the places they have visited are the best reason for Airstream owners to become involved in our great club.
